# Interpretative notes - 23/24 Accounts

## Treasurer's Report 2023/24

The income and expenditure account for the year ended 30 September 2024 is attached.

## Income

Income in the year to 30 September 2024 of £7,718.51 was achieved.

The running of the annual Tay Ten event brought in a surplus of £1,794.30 to our funds and the Brig Bash a surplus of £877.69.

Notable other income items include the claiming of Gift Aid for membership years 21/22 and 22/23, bringing in £1,250.22 and a Donation of £300.

#### Expenses

Expenses in the year to 30 September 2024 were £7,859.42.

Expenditure overall this year was very similar to 22/23, with new items being offset by savings generated elsewhere. Notable increases in expenditure have come from First Aid training ( $\pounds 660 - Note 6$ ), extra investment in new coaches ( $\pounds 759.75 - Note 5$ ) and medals for the Presentation Evening ( $\pounds 550.00 - Note 3$ ).

This was offset through the moving from chip timing to Webscorer for the Brig Bash and Tay Ten (Saving  $\pounds$ 1,827.66 – Note 1 & 2), clearing off expenditure on the Hartley Relays for last year and increasing income items mentioned above.

Other areas of significant expenditure include:

Scottish Athletics Affiliation Fees - £1335.00

Order or new clothing - £1,035.83

Website Fees - £240.86

Mob Match - £285.17

#### Overall

The resulting net deficit of income over expenditure for the year was -£140.91 (2022/23 -£2,543.12).

The club's statement of balances show the 30 September 2024 bank and cash funds held of  $\pm 6,671.14 (2022/23 \pm 6,812.05)$ .

As we move into 2024/25 the club is in a strong position to cover anticipated expenditure for the year ahead, given the increasing uptake in the clubs activities as we continue to encourage participation.
